Unlike the North American grey squirrel that's prevalent in Cape Town (having been introduced there by Cecil John Rhodes), the ground squirrel (Xerus inaurus) is a poor climber, and stays mostly on or under the ground, where colonies of up to 30 live in a maze of interconnecting burrows.
